What is the Centre for Enterprise and Law?

- Every semester, the CEL recruits top performing business and law students in both Undergraduate and Graduate programs.
- Led by project managers, students use their knowledge, skills and abilities to produce business deliverables and legal support for local, thriving entrepreneurs









Example Project: Feasibility Study

- Answers the question:
 - "does this idea make sense?"
- We will examine some of the following:
 - Potential opportunity
 - External/competitive environment
 - Legal environment



Consulting

Business

- Business plans
 - Marketing analysis
 - Financial analysis
- Funding searches
- Grant proposals

Law

- Novelty search
- Trademark analysis
- Legal opinions







Costs

- Average business consulting = \$200/hr
- Average law fees
 - \$1500 Novelty Search
 - \$800 Trademark Search
 - \$2000 Privacy Policy
 - \$5000 Shareholders' Agreement
- Typical CEL timeframe
 - 80 hrs (business)
 - 40 hrs (law)
- Total cost: \$1600 + \$1500 = **\$3100**









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Internship/Mentorship Program

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Details

- 16 weeks long
- Up to \$5000 in internship funds
- Milestone setting
- Mentorship from community leader/entrepreneur



Eligibility

- Must be a student or recent graduate in Windsor-Essex County or looking to move to the area
- Must be willing to work with the CEL and local mentor(s)
- Must have a business idea and is properly prepared to start their business (completed business plan, etc...)
 - OR must have a business and is looking to grow the business

- 1. Describe your education, work experience
- 2. Describe your product and/or service
 - b) Describe what makes your product unique or competitive
- 3. Describe what actions you have taken to date to begin your business.
 - b) Does your product require intellectual property ownership (patents, copyrights, trademarks, etc...)? If so, do you own these rights?
 - c) Do you have a business plan?
- 4. Describe how you have funded your business activities to date.
- 5. If funded (up to \$5000), what are your plans for moving forward with your business?
- 6. Can you describe some attributes of an ideal mentor that might help you move forward with your venture?
